Whether students are working together or individually, their classroom needs furniture that quickly and easily supports both. That's why flexibility is an upgrade desired by 63% of teachers.



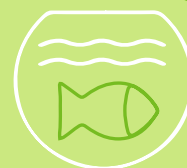

Enhancing the physical characteristics of learning spaces resulted in improved performance in reading, writing, and mathematics by 16%, with classroom flexibility credited for a full quarter of that improvement.²

As a result, students are more engaged, which reduces the possibility of off-task behavior.⁴

A recent survey of one school district's student wellness centers indicates that 96% of student respondents reported that the calming room improved their sense of safety and well-being.⁵

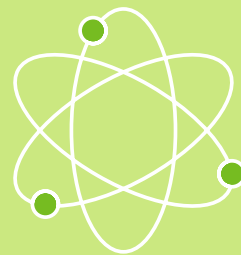






STEAM

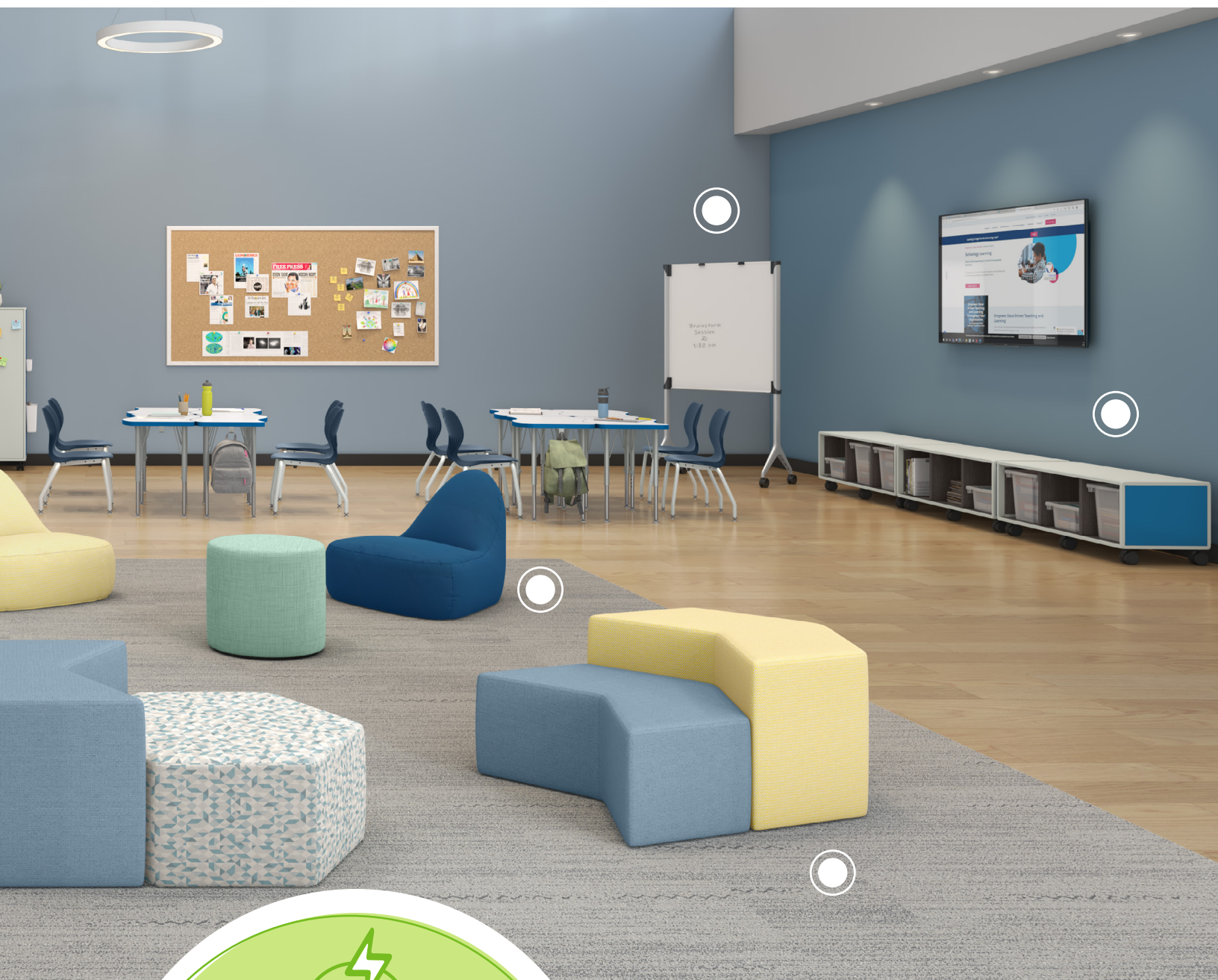






Knowledge Center

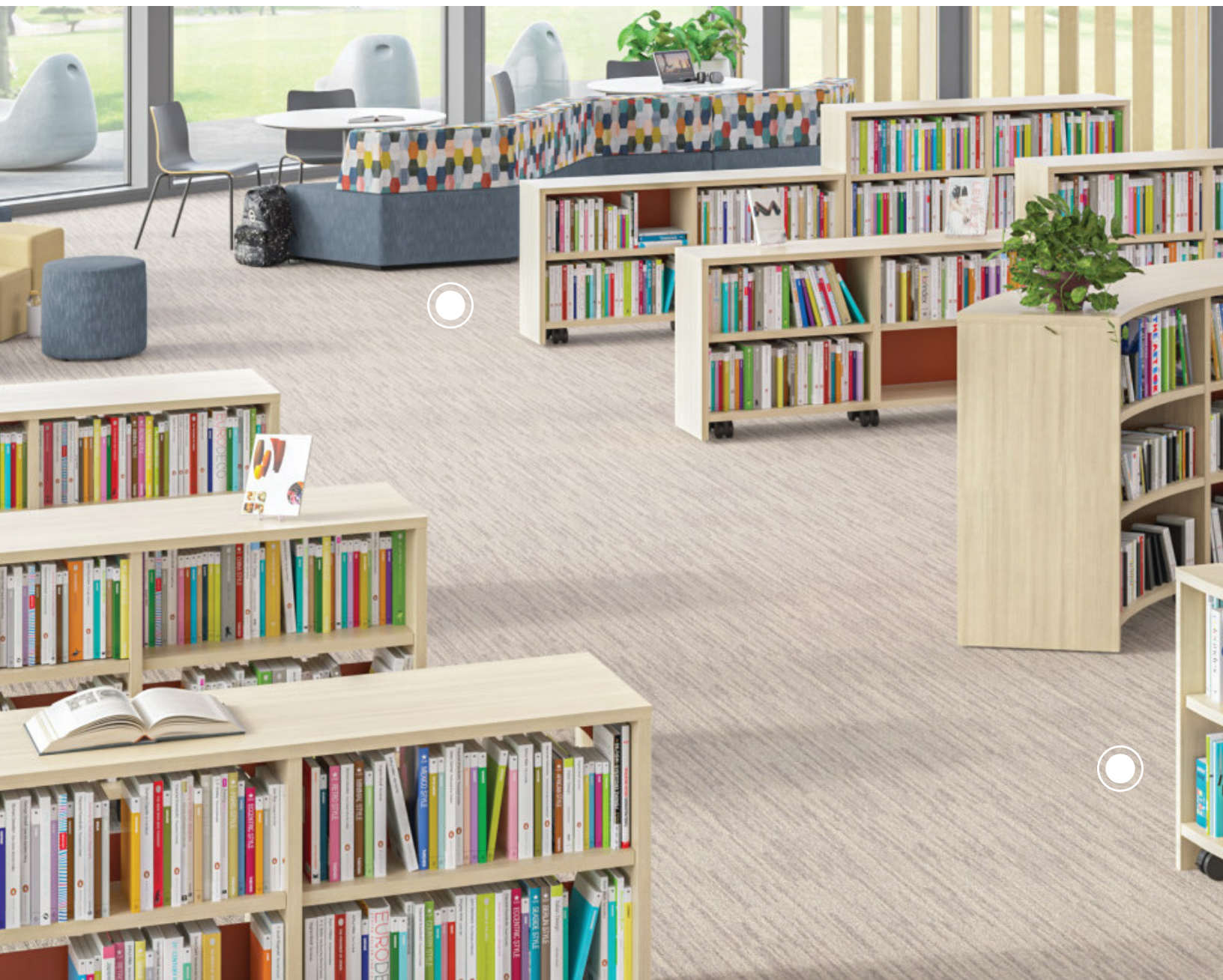
Study Hall

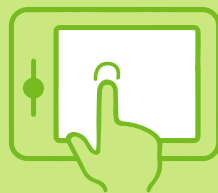
One recent study indicates that in schools with a full-time, certified librarian, nearly 8% of students scored Advanced on their reading assessments. Schools with full-time librarians also had fewer students score below the Basic level than those without librarians. And this proportional difference continued through high school.¹⁰



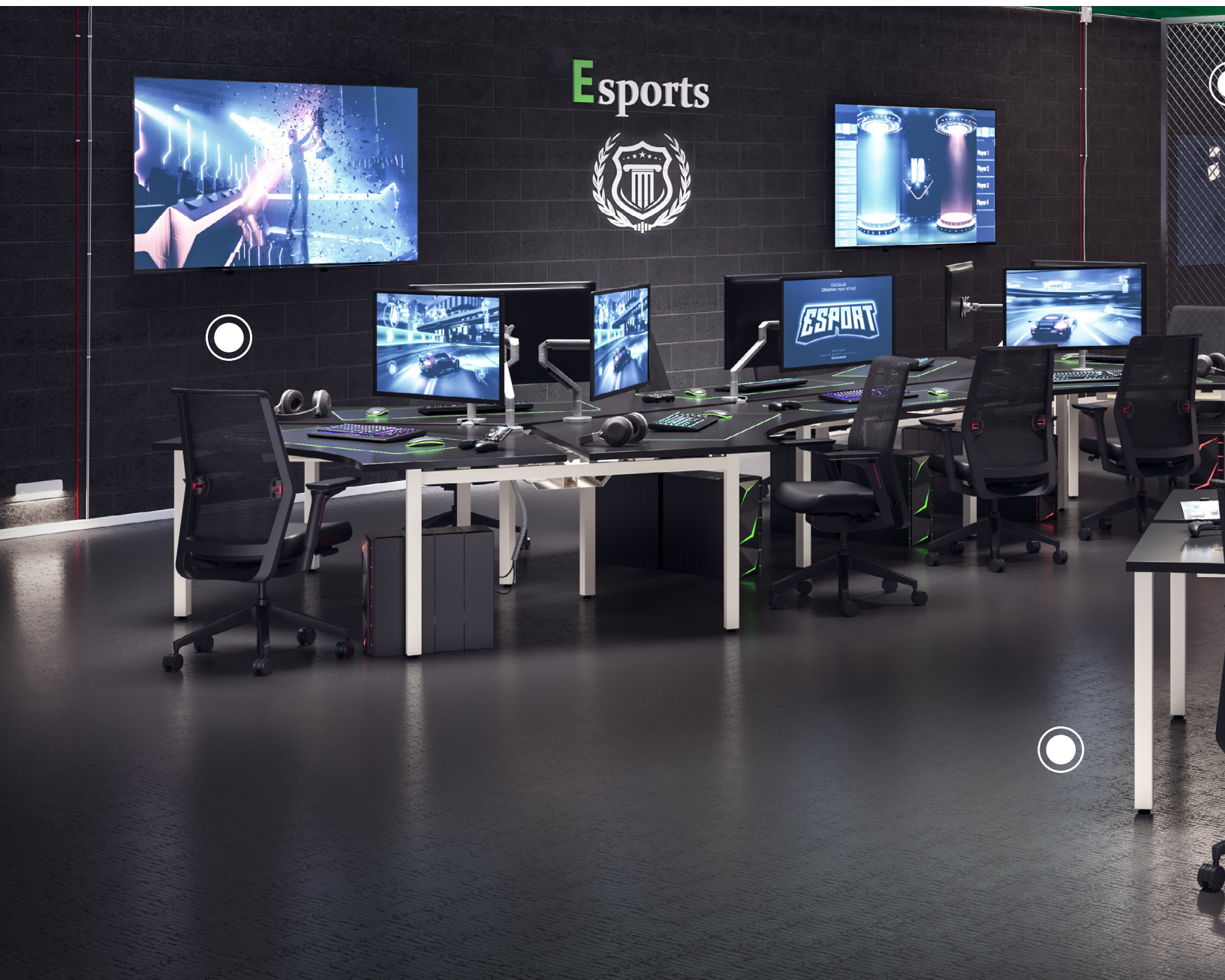
Computer Lab

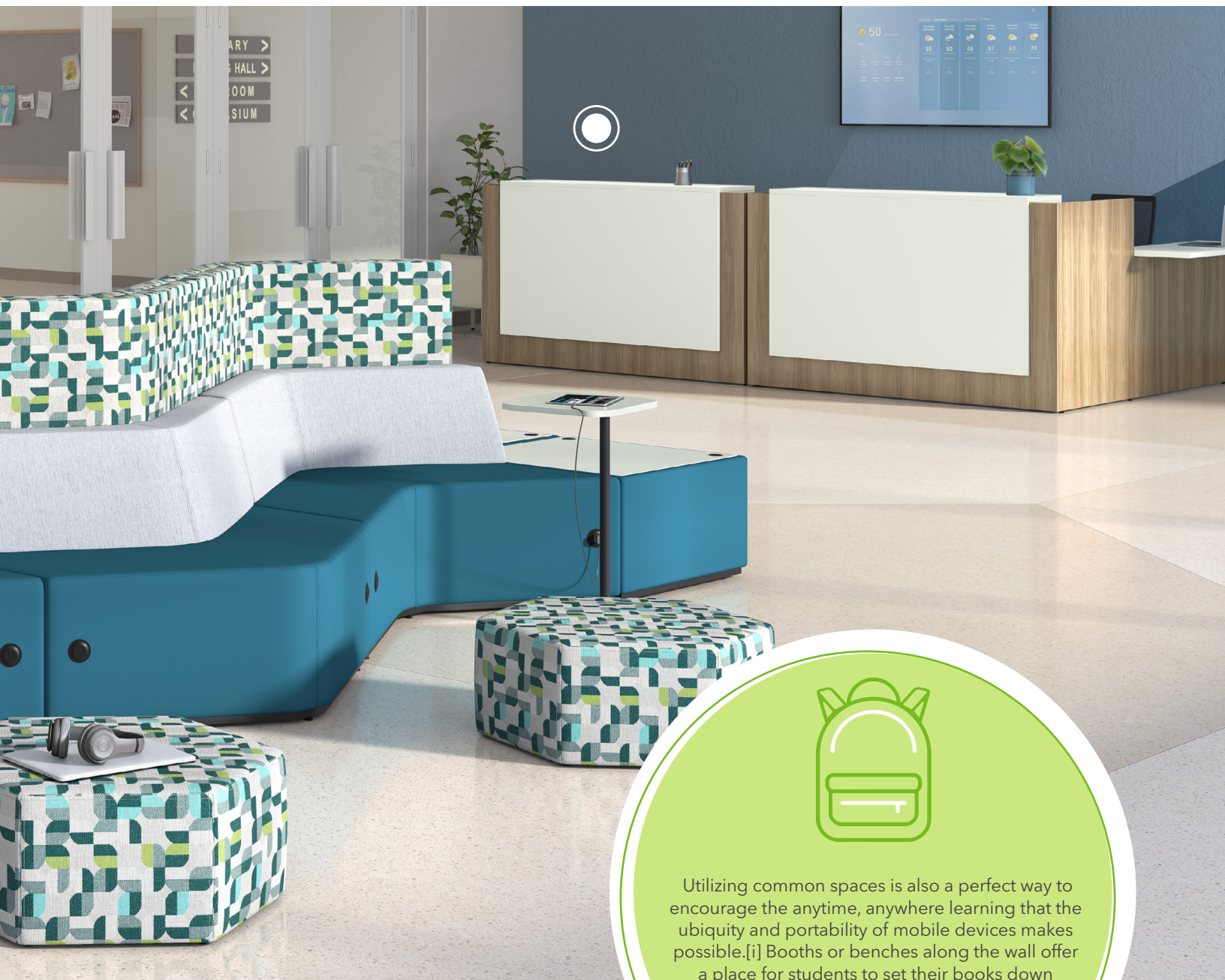






Welcome Spaces

Principal's Office

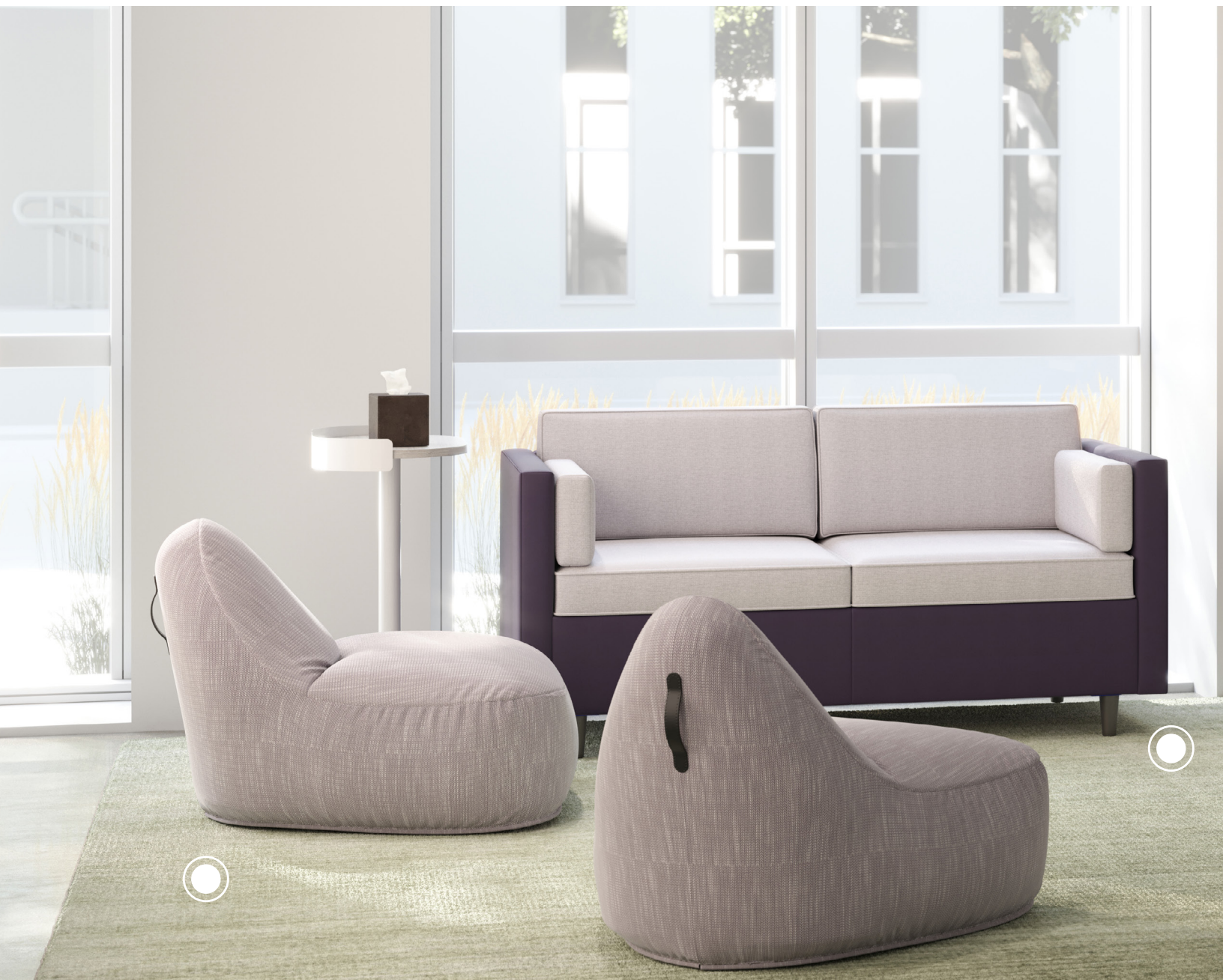

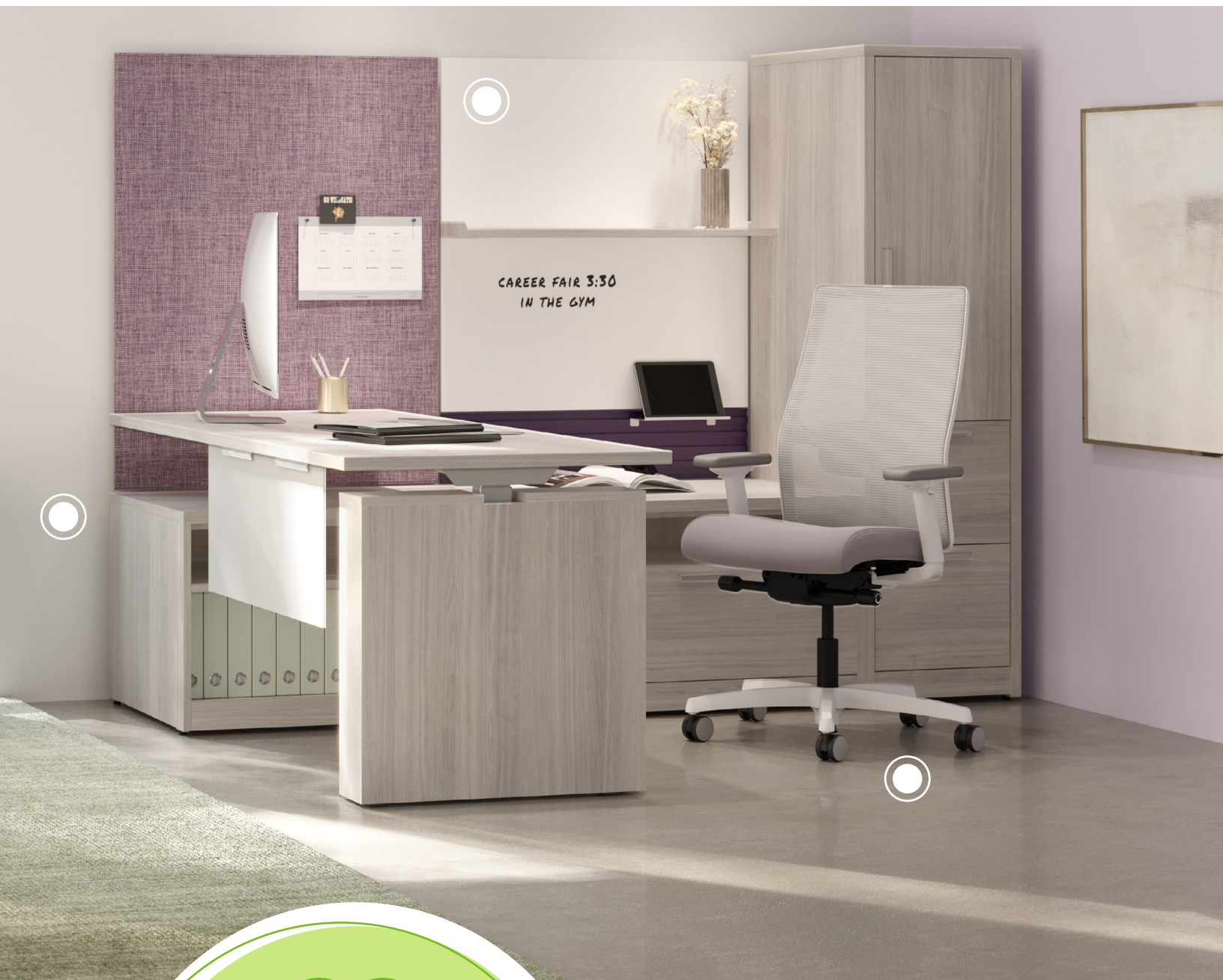






Guidance Counselor's Office

Nationally, teacher turnover in public school districts costs upwards of \$8.5 billion each year. Bearing this in mind, supporting educators' well-being is a key strategy for superintendents to improve teacher retention and reducing attrition.¹⁶
